► RESIDENT NOTIFICATION LETTER

Dear Neighbor:

In coordination with the Village of Oak Lawn's Regional Water System - Transmission Main infrastructure improvement, I would like to provide you with information about the ongoing Transmission Main Project in your neighborhood. The Project's private contractor has completed portions of the work on the improvements adjacent to your neighborhood and will soon be continuing with the next stages in your neighborhood. The following information should answer questions you may have about the project.

Project Location: Palos Hills: Intersection of Southwest Highway (IL7) & 111th Street

Remaining Work Includes the following:

- Installation of temporary traffic control and temporary traffic signals
- Installation of 60" diameter transmission main and connection to existing improvements
- Storm and sanitary sewer replacements
- Existing watermain replacement
- Street restoration

Construction Update No. 01 [07/14/2026]

The next phase of the project will include transmission main work at 111th Street and Southwest Highway. The work to install the transmission main across the intersection is scheduled to begin on Tuesday July 21st, 2026.

The work will entail temporary traffic control measures, including lane closures thru the intersection and associated detours. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction. Intermittent stops are also likely during certain phases of the work. It is anticipated that travel times through the intersection will be slower than normal and motorists are encouraged to use alternate routes.

The work will proceed on a 24/7 basis until we have reached the other side of the intersection.

The total duration of the work is expected to last a maximum of 8 days and be completed on 07/29/2026.
